# Make Year 9 Drama Matter

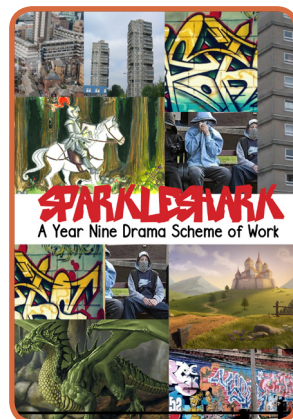

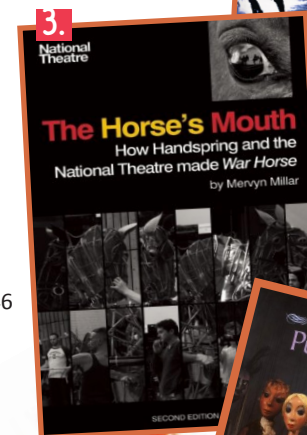

# Play with Puppets

With exam pressure reduced at Key Stage 3, why not take the opportunity to look at the more fun aspects of theatre: puppets? It would be an enjoyable focus for younger students as well as a topic to broaden their understanding of theatre props, or a chance to teach a more unusual, stylised staging production method.

You could start by looking at the incredible puppets created by Handsprung for War Horse and then move beyond this into the history of puppetry, or look at modern theatre companies such as Forkbeard Fantasy and their use of puppets. The possibilities are endless!

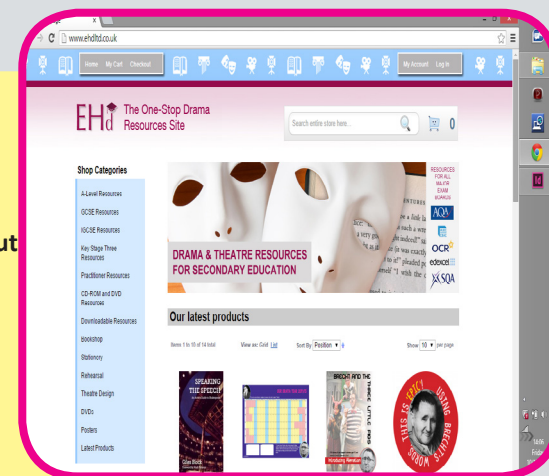
