Rules of the competition:

Round One-The Semi Final

1. The pronouncer will announce the word to be spelled (from the list on the left).

2. The speller listens carefully to the pronouncer and will then write it down.

3. The answer will be given. If you get the spelling correct, you will remain in the competition.

4. If the spelling was incorrect, that speller is eliminated from the game. (Eliminated spellers will then help to run the spelling contest, by checking other spellers' answers.)

5. The two winners from Round One will be the last speller from Year 5 and the last speller from Year 6. (In the event of more than 2 remaining in the game, a tie break round will be used until 2 spellers are left.)

Round Two-The Final

6. The last 2 spellers (one from Year 5 and one from Year 6) will go head to head in a spelling challenge. This time, they will not be given a list of the spellings to revise beforehand.
